

Student Responsibilities as a Member of The Host Family

As a member of the Host Family, I understand I will

- · Participate in family activities and regular family meals and discussions around the table after dinner.
- Eat meals, attend church once a week, and participate in general chores shared by the family.
- Respect and follow the Host Family's rules while living in the house.
- Be responsible for my own laundry.
- Be responsible to keep my room and bathroom clean and make bed daily!
- Make sure my Host Family knows where I am at ALL times.
- Attend school each day. If more than two days are missed, I will seek a doctor's care.
- Not make weekend plans or evening plans without discussing it with my Host Family first.
- · Receive permission from my Host Family before I stay overnight with friends.
- Provide my Host Family with the name, address, and telephone number of any friend's house I may be staying with.
- Be home for dinner at the determined time by the Host Family. If not, I will notify the family by telephone at least 2 hours in advance.
- Be home on school nights by 9:00 pm and on weekends by 10:00 pm. Time deadlines may be extended for special occasions, but only with the consent of the host parents.
- Not invite guests to the home without prior permission from the Host Family.
- Not have guests of the opposite sex for overnight stays.
- Be responsible to be ready for school on time in the mornings and not make my family late for work or my American siblings late for school.
- Be diligent and work hard to be successful in school. This is my job while studying in the USA.
- Be able to make calls with permission from my Host Family. All calls must be completed by 10:00 pm and no incoming calls are allowed before 7:30 am and after 10:00 pm. Be responsible to pay for all long distance phone calls made by me. If I want an extra line, I must speak to my Host Family.
- Show consideration and tolerance to my Host Family members.
- Respect the privacy of my Host Family.
- Not smoke or drink alcoholic beverages.
- Internet use will be under the supervision of the Host Family. Violent or excessive gaming, excessive time on QQ or other social media sites or on the phone will be limited and monitored.
- Internet use will be shut off at 12 am (in the evening) and 11 pm on the weekdays. Viewing of objectionable material including violence and pornography as determined by the Host Family is strictly forbidden and could result in being asked to leave school.
- Speak to the International Student Coordinator if a problem arises with my Host Family.
- Not make changes with my Host Family arrangements without speaking to the International Student Coordinator. If I make a change without permission, I may be expelled from school.

I understand I am attending a Christian school and living with a Christian host family and that I am expected to participate in a Christian way of life at school and at home. I am expected to abide by this agreement, the FCA Parent/Student Handbook, and all International Student Handbook for Homestay.

If I do not follow these policies, I would be breaking this agreement and could be expelled from school. I understand that I violate the terms of this Agreement, my parents and my agency will be contacted immediately.
